



Matrix-Tech has servers dedicated to FTP uploading for its clients.

How FTP option works:

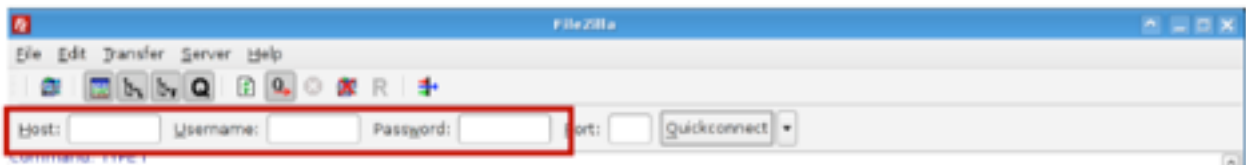
1. Create an account sending an email to customer@matrix-tech.com with subject "FTP_ACCOUNT".
2. When you receive by email the access to FTP area created by Matrix-Tech on its servers, upload cd/dvd's master through a ftp upload software .*



***FileZilla Client** is a cross-platform supporting Windows, Linux, Mac OS X and more. Free download available here: <http://filezilla-project.org/>

When you have installed the software, in order to access the Matrix-Tech's FTP area you have to:

1. fill the gaps with the info Matrix-Tech has sent to you



2. create a folder with the name and/or unique code of job and save inside it the project's files.

- DISK's IMAGE ISO
- For DVD9 folders need separated layer0 and layer1 • File Hash generated with MD5***

** To convert disk into DDP 2.0 you can use GEAR PRO MASTERING EDITION

*** **MD5** means **Message Digest algorithm 5**. It's a simple open source Windows checker to make sure that a file that you have downloaded is not corrupt.
